AMENDMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION RE-ISSUED ON THE 29 NOVEMBER 2022 FOR THE DAMLAAGTE SOLAR PV FACILITY GRID CONNECTION, FREE STATE PROVINCE

The re-issued Environmental Authorisation (EA) for the abovementioned application issued by this Department on 29 November 2022, your application for amendment of the EA received by the Department on 23 March 2023, the acknowledgement letter dated 03 April 2023 and the additional information received on 11 April 2023, refer.

Based on a review of the reason for requesting an amendment to the above EA, this Department, in terms of Chapter 5 of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014 as amended, has decided to amend the EA dated 29 November 2022, as amended, as follows:

Amendment 1: Change to the name of the holder:

The holder of the EA reflected as:

'South Africa Mainstream Renewable Power Developments (Pty) Ltd.'

Is hereby amended to:

'Damlaagte PV Facility (Pty) Ltd.'

Reason for amendment:

Damlaagte PV Facility (Pty) Ltd is the Project Company Name and is a subsidiary of the Development Company, South Africa Mainstream Renewable Power Development (Pty) Ltd. Damlaagte PV Facility (Pty) Ltd is the company responsible for the development phase of the authorised solar PV facility. The contact details of the holder remain the same.

This amendment letter must be read in conjunction with the re-issued EA dated 29 November 2022.

In terms of the Promotion of Administrative Justice Act, 2000 (Act No 3 of 2000), you are entitled to the right to fair, lawful and reasonable administrative action; and to written reasons for administrative action that affects you negatively. Further your attention is drawn to the provisions of the Protection of Personal Information Act, 2013 (Act no. 4 of 2013) which stipulates that the Department should conduct itself in a responsible manner when collecting, processing, storing and sharing an individual or another entity's personal information by holding the Department accountable should the Department abuses or compromises your personal information in any way.

In terms of Regulation 4(2) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014, as amended (the EIA Regulations), you are instructed to notify all registered interested and affected parties, in writing and within fourteen (14) days of the date of the EA, of the Department's as well as the provisions regarding the submission of appeals that are contained in the Regulations.

Your attention is drawn to Chapter 2 of National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) National Appeal Regulations published under Government Notice R993 in Government Gazette No. 38303 dated 08 December 2014 (National Appeal Regulations, 2014), which prescribe the appeal procedure to be followed. Kindly include a copy of this document (National Appeal Regulations, 2014) with the letter of notification to interested and affected parties in this matter.

Should any person wish to lodge an appeal against this decision, he/she must submit the appeal to the appeal administrator, and a copy of the appeal to the applicant, any registered interested and affected party, and any organ of state with interest in the matter within 20 days from the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the registered interested and affected parties by the applicant; or the date that the notification of the decision was sent to the applicant by the Department, whichever is applicable.
